





The Women, Men & Families We Serve




1,177 total clients





Program Services

12 new videos and **29** new lessons were added to our Earn While You Learn incentive program including: *CPR Training, Pediatric Emergencies & Routine Illnesses.*

Women's Jail Ministry

140 total inmates **304** inmate interactions
17% have abortion history **55%** report abuse history

Consultants share the Gospel, engage in spiritual discussions and pray with incarcerated clients each time they visit the jail.

35 care packages to foster families caring for drug-exposed babies
20 local foster children, age 14+, matched with Heartbeats mentors
100 boutique points for foster families with new or emergency placements

Post-Abortive Ministry



7 women experienced restoration through **Surrendering the Secret**, an 8-week interactive Bible study designed to lead post-abortive women through a path of healing.
